Certificate of the Boundaries of Kaapahu, District
of Hamakua, Island of Hawaii 3^d of U.

Upon the application of Henry Cooper, and by
virtue of the authority vested in me by law, as
sole Commissioner of Land Boundaries for the
Island of Hawaii 3^d of U., I hereby decide
and certify the boundaries of the Ahupuaa of
Kaapahu, District of Hamakua, Island of
Hawaii, to be as hereinafter set forth.

Given under my hand, at Honolulu,

this fifteenth day of May A.D. 1871

Boundaries of Kaapahu.

Beginning at a point of the ledge marked X on the
edge of the Pali at the sea shore, at the corner of
"Kaapahu" & the "Grove" land "Waikahalulu".

Thence Mauka along said land North 11° $46'$ 92.00 -
chains to a pile of rocks. Thence $S. 24^{\circ}$ $W.$ (at 9.7 -
chains cross Government Road) $+ 3.80$ chains to top of
small hill, thence $S. 15^{\circ}$ $W.$ 1670 chains to a pine tree
marked X on a low ridge forming the West bank
of the Kihailamamahua Kahawai. Thence
up and along said ridge $S. 11^{\circ}$ $E.$ 575 chains to

angle: $S. 5^{\circ} E. 28.50$ chains to angle: thence
 $S. 1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E. 18.00$ chains to an ohia marked X.

At this point the boundary leaves the Ridge.
Thence up along the center of the Kūbūlālamahu
Kahawai $S. 2^{\circ} E. 52.00$ chains to an ohia marked X:
Thence $S. 14^{\circ} W. 33.00$ chains to a large ohia tree
marked X... on the top of a small hill at a point
known as "Kishi" at the mauka corner of the land
called "Waikealulu". Thence in auka along
the Govt. land "Papalei" $S. 5^{\circ} E. 28.00$ chains to the
mauka $S. W.$ corner of this land on the boundary
of Papalei to a Kūbū tree marked X on the
top of a small hill called "Puu Shi".

Thence along the head of this land (which is
bounded on the mauka side by the land Papalei)
 $S. 88^{\circ} E. 15.00$ chains to an ohia tree marked X:

This tree stands at the head of the Kahawai
"Kaolei" at a point known as the mauka $S. E.$
corner of this land; at this point it is cut
off by the lands Papalei and Kāunoaalii.

Thence makai along said land $N. 8^{\circ} W. 37.00$ chains
to a large ohia tree marked X at the extreme mauka
point of the Govt. land "Kalua":

Thence makai along the center of the Kaolei
 Gulch $N. 25.00$ chains: Thence $N. 39^{\circ} E. 28.00$
chains: Thence $N. 5^{\circ} E. 25.50$ chains: Thence
 $N. 22^{\circ} E. 35.00$ chains to an ohia tree marked X
 $S. E.$ corner of Kanakaonae's 96 acre lot in this
land of "Kaapahu": Thence $N. 37^{\circ} W. 20.32$ chains:
Thence $N. 20^{\circ} E. 20.32$ chains to a Kūbū tree marked

X at the N.E. corner of Kanakaonui lot:
Thence N. 5° E 12.50 chains to the junction of the
Kahawai of Kaolele and Kuiduilamalahua
Thence down along the center of the last named
Kahawai to a rock "boulder" marked X in the
mouth of the Kahawai at the sea shore.
Thence along the Pali at the sea shore to the
place of commencement.
