HABITAT CONSERVATION PLAN (HCP)**

I am writing as an individual Councilmember on the Kaua'i County Council to express my strong support for the Kaua'i Island Utility Cooperative's (KIUC) Second Draft Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP), currently under review by the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife (DOFAW).

As a government official committed to the sustainability of Hawai'i's natural and built environments, I commend KIUC's efforts to engage in transparent planning, community consultation, and meaningful environmental stewardship. The Draft HCP represents a significant and commendable step toward balancing infrastructure resilience with biodiversity protection on Kaua'i. As reflected, KIUC has demonstrated a strong commitment to conservation of these species by implementing a majority of the HCP prior to it being finalized and approved, and by the significant amount of powerline minimization that can be seen on powerlines across the island.

KIUC's Draft HCP reflects a proactive and scientifically grounded effort to address the impacts of necessary utility operations on federally and state-listed threatened and endangered species. These species are integral to Kaua'i's native ecosystem, and their protection is a shared responsibility that requires coordinated action from both public and private sectors. This second draft addresses comments from the public and Endangered Species Recovery Committee, and multiple sets of comments from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and DOFAW.
